We regard the lawful and correct treatment of personal information by Allied Consultants Ltd as very important to successful operations and for maintaining confidence between ourselves and those with whom we deal. We therefore make every effort to ensure that personal information is treated lawfully and correctly.

Malta Business School and Allied Consultants Ltd need to collect a range of personal information in order to operate.
